

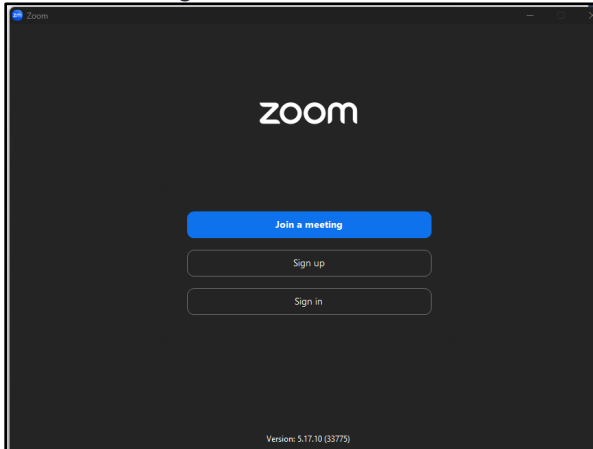
Log Into Zoom Using SSO:

Zoom Desktop Application:

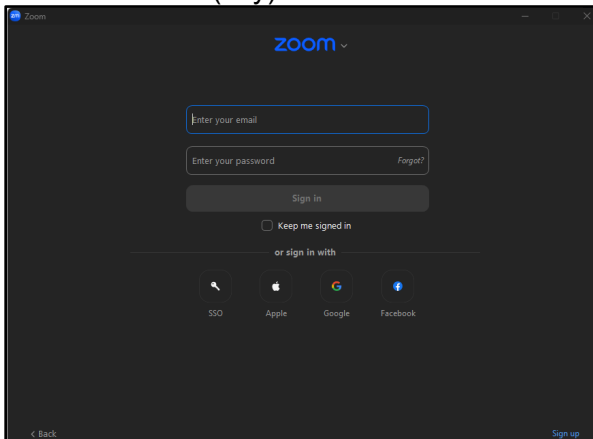
1. Open the Zoom desktop application that is installed on your computer. If you do not see the application on your desktop, go to the window search box and type in Zoom, then select the “application” to open it.



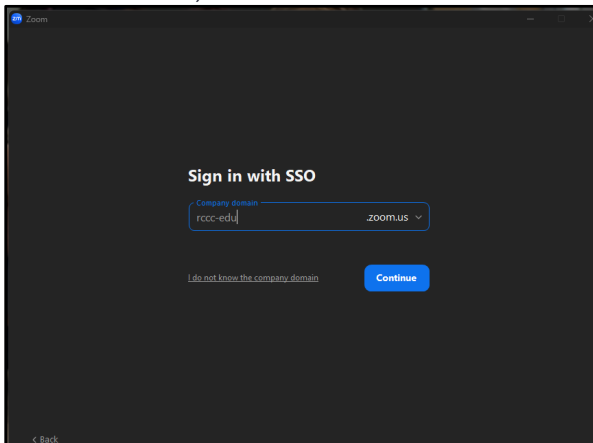
2. Select the “Sign in” button.



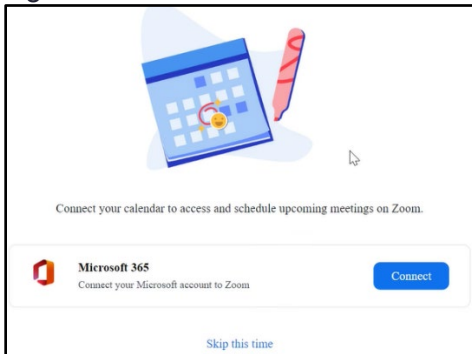
3. Select the SSO (key) icon located at the bottom under “or sign in with.”



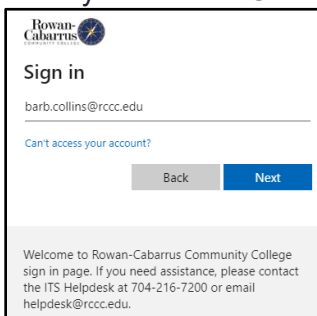
4. Enter rccc-edu, then select the “Continue” button.



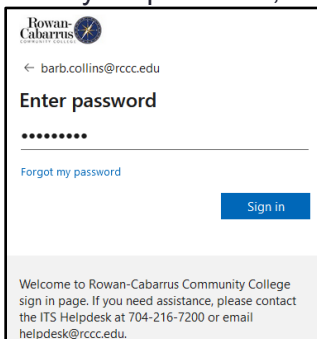
5. A web page may display asking you if you would like to connect your Microsoft 365 account to Zoom. Select the “Connect” button.
Note: If you do not see this web page, then you will continue logging into your Zoom account with your Rowan-Cabarrus email address and password which is outlined in step 6. If you already signed into your Microsoft 365 account, you will not be prompted to log in.



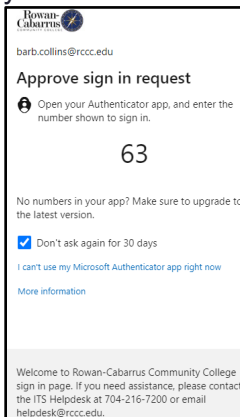
6. Enter your Rowan-Cabarrus email address, then select the “Next” button.



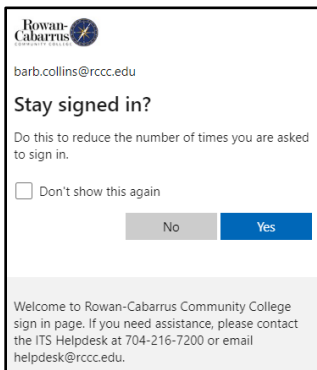
7. Enter your password, then select the “Sign in” button.



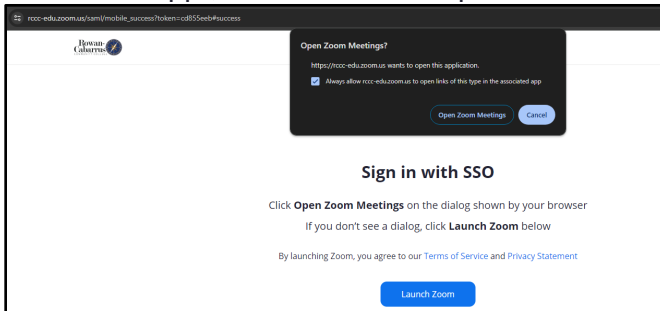
8. A window may display asking you to approve the sign in request. Enter the number in your Microsoft Authenticator App or enter the code from the text or email you receive.



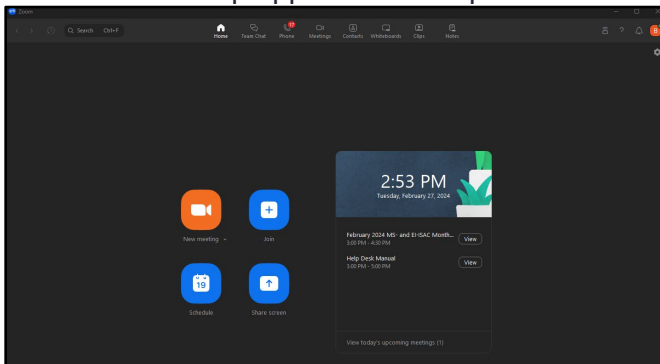
9. Select the “No” button.



10. Check the box “Always allow rccc-edu.zoom.us to open links of this type in the associated app”, then select the “Open Zoom Meetings” button.

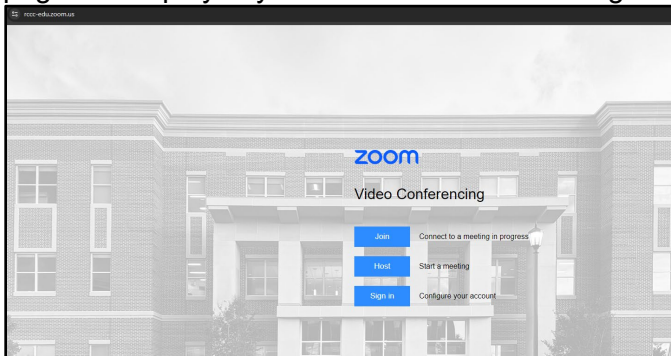


11. The Zoom desktop application will open.




Zoom Web Portal:


1. Enter <https://rccc-edu.zoom.us/> in your web browser, then press enter. The Zoom web page will display in your window. Select the “Sign in” button.



2. Select the SSO (key) icon located at the bottom under “Or sign in with.”
