

Exporting Footage using 0-876-32 on a 0-876-01/ 04 DVR

1. Step one will be to plug a 32GB SD card into the 0-876-32 Easycheck module.



2. Plug the Easycheck module into the USB port on the DVR.



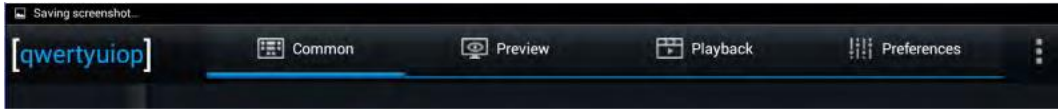
3. Establish the WiFi connection from the Tablet or Smartphone with the DVR via the EasyCheck module. [See Pairing Guide](#)
4. Once the Wifi connection is made you can now open the Easycheck App.



5. Login on the Easycheck app to the DVR (Username is admin, Password is eagle.) then press Login.



6. Now the App and DVR are connected Select the Playback tab.



7. From the Calendar select the day you wanted to get footage from.



8. Now select the channels you need footage from. Then Press next button



9. Now you will be able to view footage from the selected cameras to find the clip you need.



10. Now press Video Export.
11. Using the Time bar slide to start time then once set press start time.
12. Now use the time bar to select end time then press end time.
13. Now press the backup button.
14. Another sub window will show up with clip details, Start, End Times, Size of clip, remaining storage on the SD card. Now select the Video(avi) Data as then the footage can be played back in most media players.
15. Now Press OK to start to download to the SD card.
16. A new window with the download progress bar will come up.
17. IT will come up with message when completed the download
18. Now you can take the SD card out play back as required.
