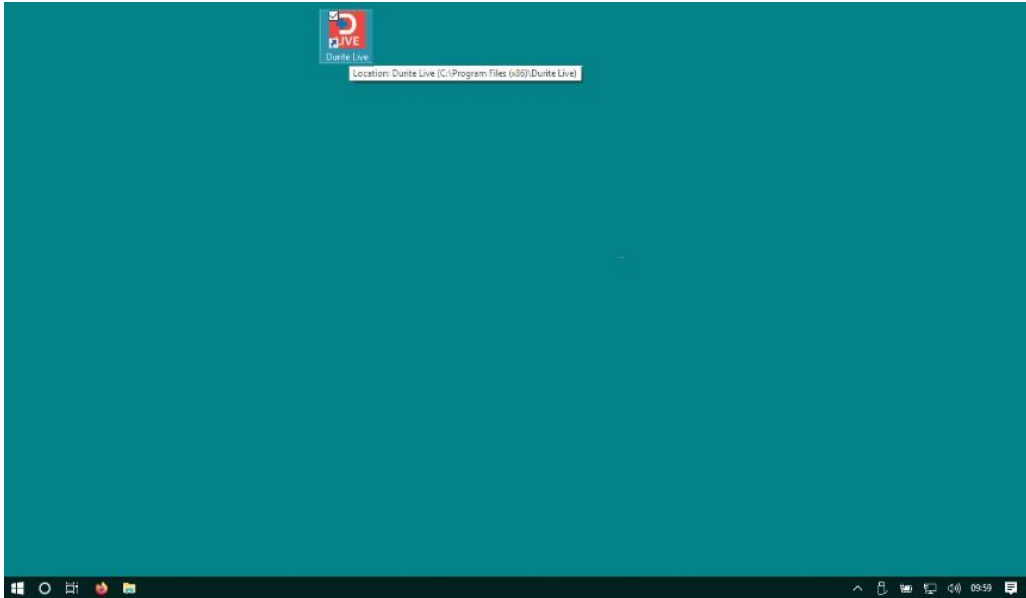
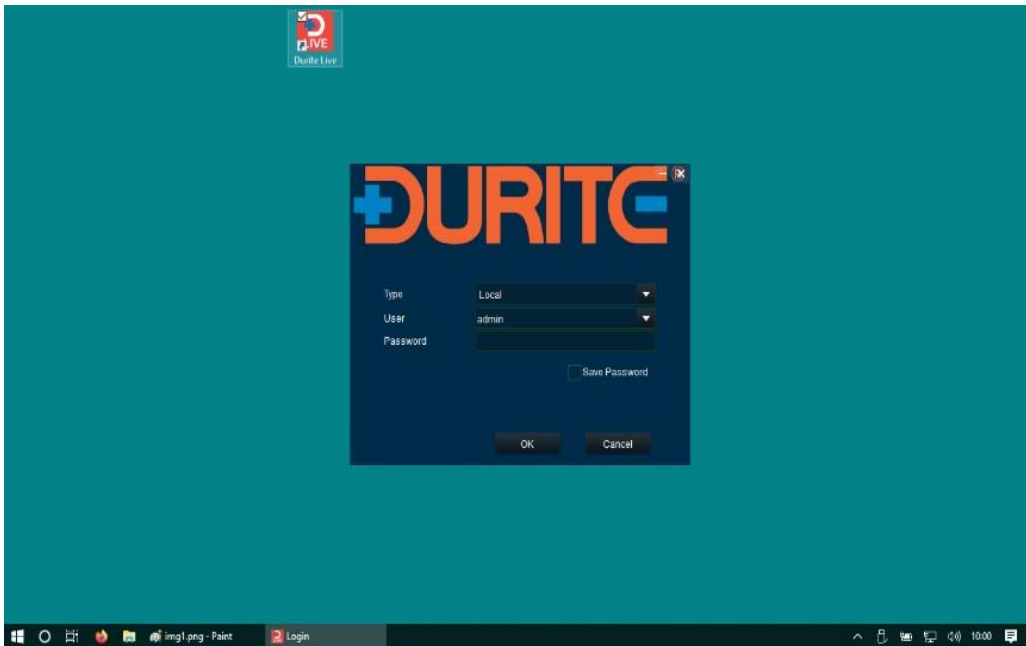


Access Footage on 4G Dashcam via Durite Live in Local Mode

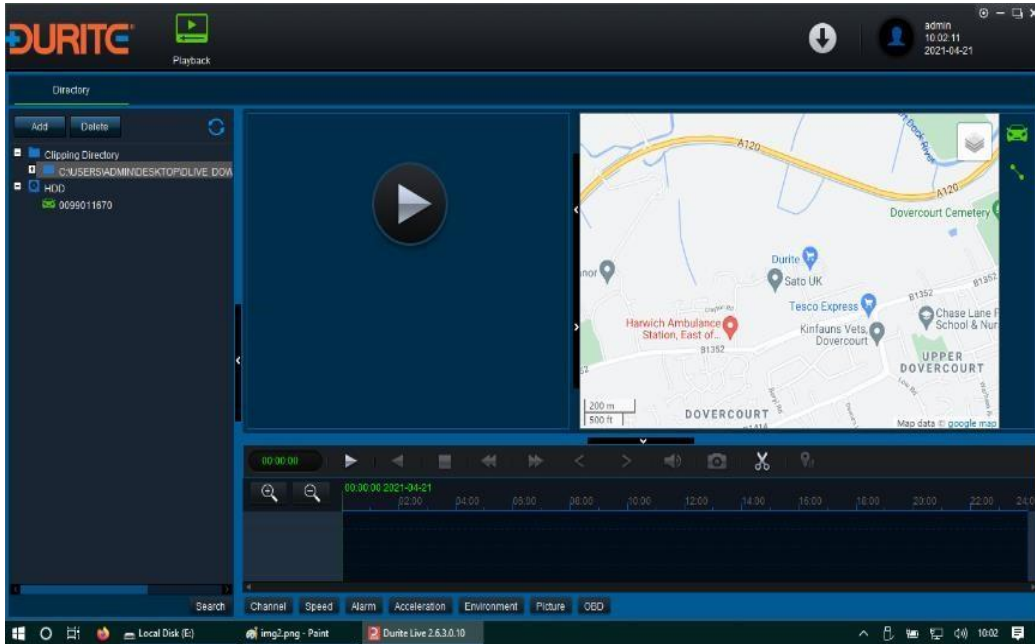
1. Open Durite Live Software.



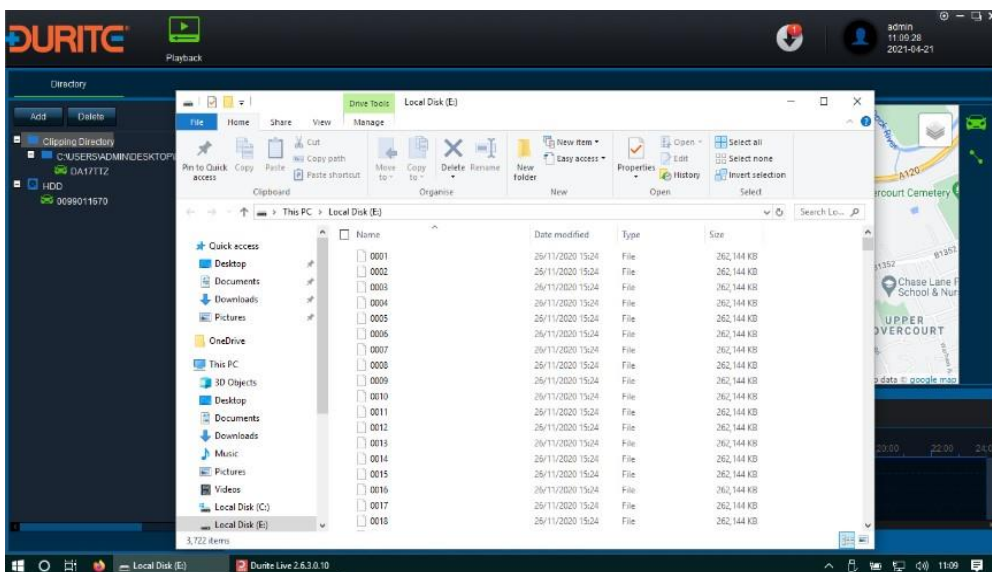
2. Set to Local Mode, User: admin Password: no password required then press OK.



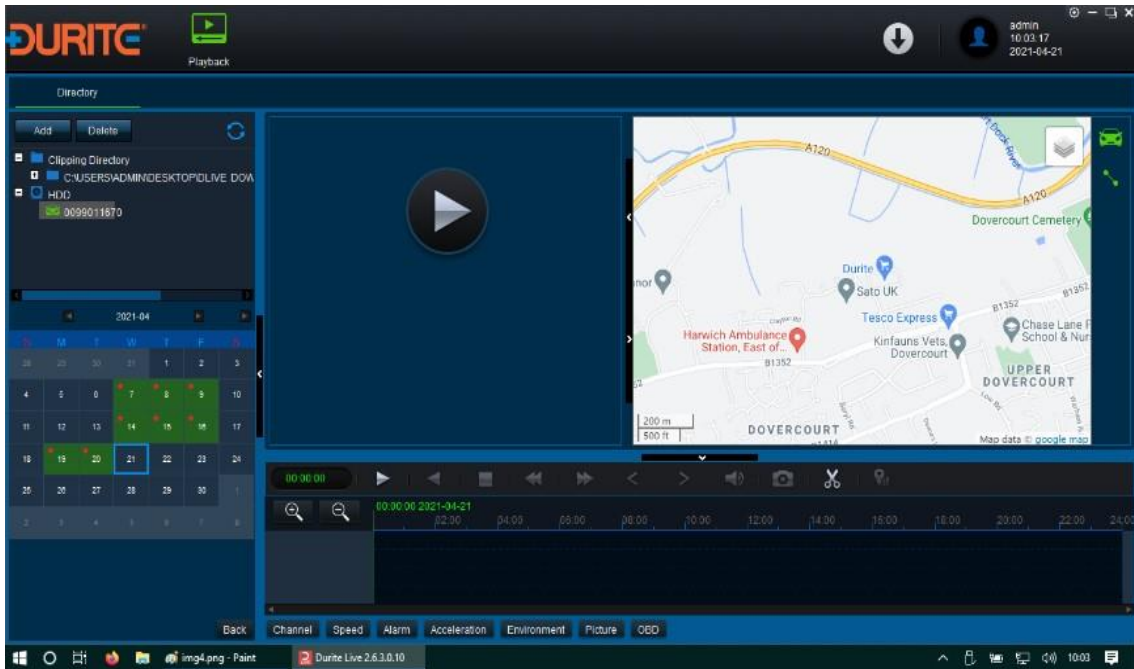
3. Now Plug the SD card from the Dashcam into the PC .



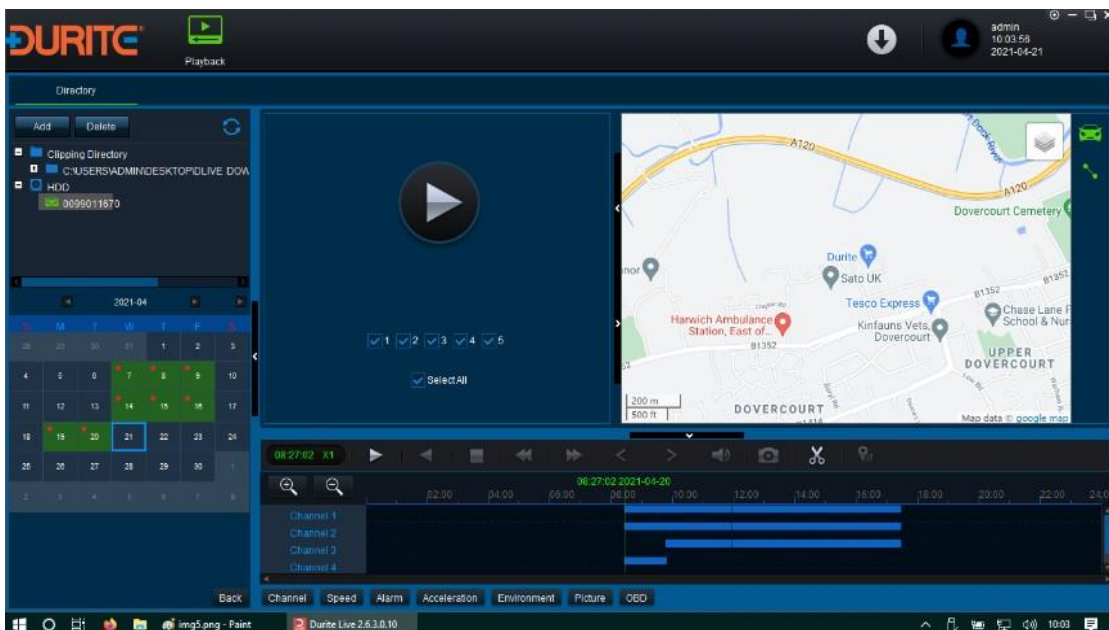
4. Once the SDD is connected then it will open the below screen showing saved files you can close this screen as access of files easier via the Durite Live software.



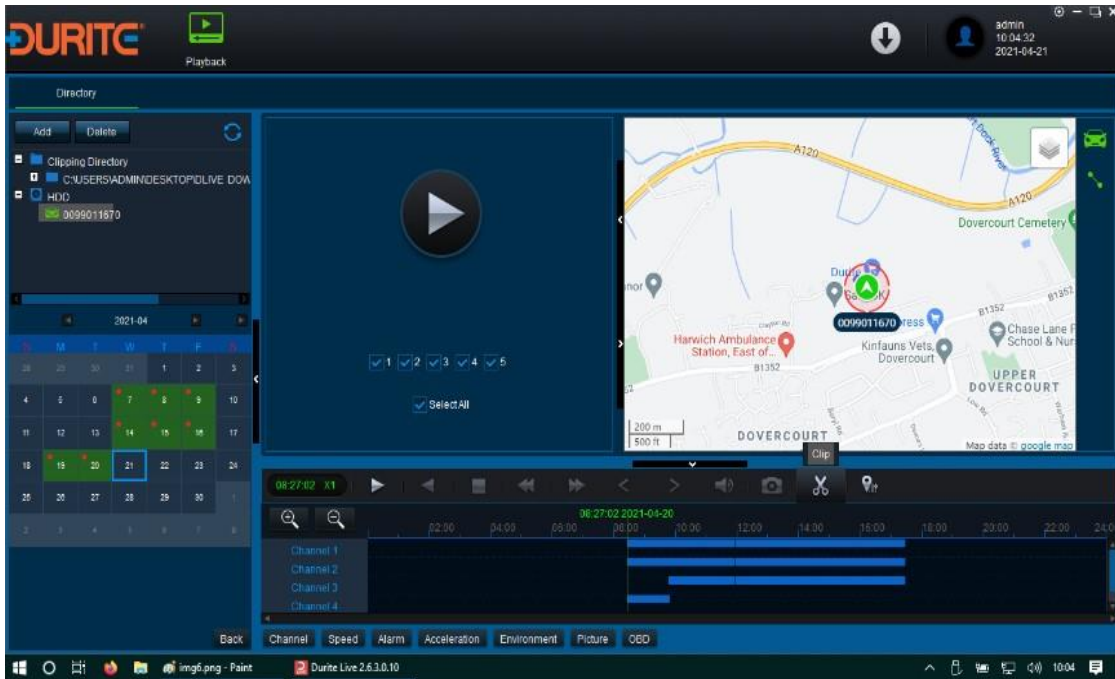
- Once You have Double Clicked on the HDD it will load the calendar The Days with stored footage will be highlighted Green Now Double Click on day required.



- This will now have the camera selection option in the centre panel on the software Now Tick the boxes of the camera's footage will be needed from.
- In the Bottom Panel you will see a timeline bar showing blue bars where data has been captured from cameras.
- Now you can click on the Timeline which will bring up a green centre line for clip to be downloaded.



- Now by using the Scissors Button you can now open the Clip menu you can use the timeline slider to narrow down time of footage required. Once you have selected time frame Press OK to open Clip Settings Menu.



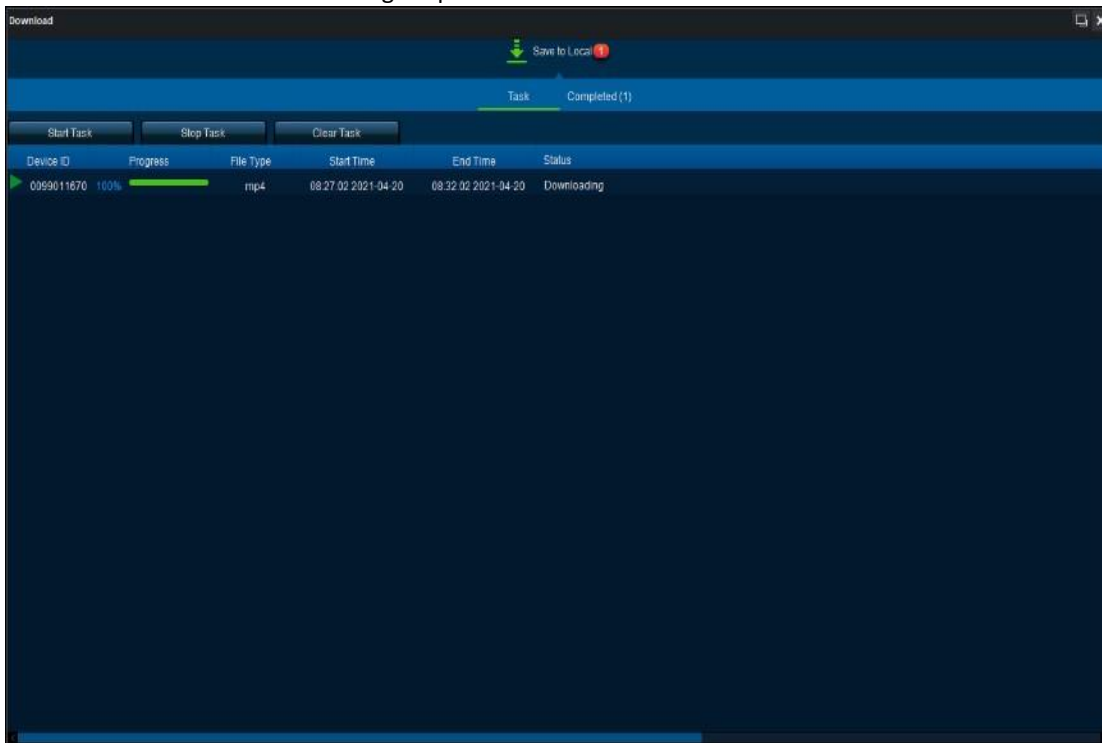
- In the Clip Settings screen, you can now select footage start and end times, Cameras required To Be Able to view video footage easier select MP4 format, Then Path Where you want to put the downloaded video files.
- Once this has been carried out press the OK button in Clip Settings screen



12. Now up the top Right of the screen you will see the Download symbol turn Green showing that you are currently downloaded footage from the HDD.



13. If you click on this, you will open the below screen showing download progress for the selected footage clip.



14. Once the progress has reached 100% you can close this window using the cross in top right of screen.
15. You can now disconnect the HDD caddy from the reader and remove the USB cables and close the Durite Live Software.
16. Now you can go to the file you selected in path where you have saved the downloaded footage to and will see video files for each camera selected and these will be date and time stamped as file names for each clip.
